What's this?

The Navbar and Header Modules intent to offer an alternative to the standard (core) side column boxes. On small screens (Mobiles) the boxes are moved at the very bottom of the pages. They are therefore not useful for small devices. Header and Navbar Modules show on the top of the pages and are much more recommended for Mobile view.

You can permanent replace your side column boxes to show always the Header or Navbar module instead on all screen sizes. Or you can add a device dependent helper class to the box and header/navbar module, so on desktop view the boxes are still used, but on smaller devices the header/navbar modules will replace them.

See instructions below how to do it.

You can choose free which modules to use, depending on your taste and store needs.

Installation:

0a.) Backup your files

0b.) Backup your database

1. Upload all files included in the "uploads" directory maintaining their directory structure.

All files are new and save to upload, they will not overwrite any existing files.

2. Go to your Admin and install and configure your Navbar and/or header modules.

Alternative modules:

New Products Drop Down replaces New Products

Special Offers Drop Down replaces Special Offers

Testimonials Drop Down replaces Testimonials

3. Optional

If you wish to keep your side column box to show on desktop devices and hide on mobile and show the header/navbar module on small devices and hide them on desktop, add the following classes to the respective files:

3a. In the first line of the whats new box template:

add the following class to hide the box on small devices:

`d-none d-md-block`

So the first line should be like this:

```
<div class="card mb-2 is-product bm-whats-new d-none d-md-block">?php echo $box_attr; ?>
```

3b. header template:

In the first line add the following class to show the whats new header module on small devices:

d-md-none

So the first line should look like this:

```
<div class="col-sm-<?php echo $content_width; ?> text-center cm-header-whats-new d-md-none">
```

3b. Navbar module template:

In the first line add the following class to show the new products navbar module on small devices:

d-md-none

So the first line should look like this:

```
<li class="nav-item dropdown nb-new-products d-md-none">
```
